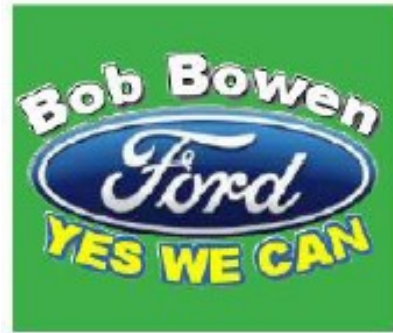

St. Patrick School of the Terre Haute Deanery is actively monitoring the incidence of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) in our region. We have been asked how COVID-19 may impact upcoming events including the Irish Dash. SPS is following guidance from local health departments and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) regarding large gatherings, including CDC recommendations on preventing the spread of COVID-19. We are taking extra precautions to ensure race day is as safe as possible. These mitigation procedures will include but are not limited to maintaining a social distance of six feet from others, masking, and sanitation of the premises.

At this time, our upcoming Irish Dash will take place as planned. However, if you are sick or feeling you are getting sick, or have been in contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or has symptoms of COVID-19, we ask that you please stay home. Additionally, if the Irish Dash must be cancelled due to COVID-19, please note that all race day fees and donations collected are non-refundable. However, all registered participants will receive their shirts and race bags.

All participants in the Irish Dash 5K Run/Walk and 1 Mile Fun Run (collectively the "events") are required to assume all risk of participation in the events by signing this release agreement: The undersigned athlete (Athlete) and on behalf of Athlete's personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and executors, fully and forever releases from all liability, including negligence, Saint Patrick's Church, St. Patrick's School, the Irish Dash Race Committee and each of their respective past, present and future shareholders, directors, officers, members, managers, employees, agents, parents, subsidiaries, affiliates, successors, an assigns, partners, and all sponsoring or co-sponsoring companies or individuals related to the events (collectively Releasees). Athlete and on behalf of Athlete's personal representatives, assigns, heirs and executors waives the right to sue Releasees for all losses and damages that arise from any injury to Athlete or Athlete's property or resulting in Athlete's death in connection with the Athlete's participation in events including but not limited to losses or damage caused by the negligence of all or any of the Releasees or otherwise, and also including any pre or post-race activities and any programs and/or giveaways conducted at the events by a sponsor or other third party. The Athlete warrants that Athlete is in good physical condition and is able to safely participate in the events. The Athlete is fully aware of the risks and hazards inherent in participating in the events and elects to voluntarily compete in the events knowing such risks. The Athlete agrees to the use of Athlete's name and photograph in broadcasts, newspapers, brochures, and other media without compensation. The Athlete acknowledges that the entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. The Athlete acknowledges that Saint Patrick's Church and Saint Patrick's School has the right to alter, change, cancel and/or postpone any of these events as a result of circumstances that would affect or impact the event which are beyond their control. The Athlete warrants that all statements made in this release agreement are true and correct and understands that Releasees have relied on them in allowing Athlete to participate in the events. Athlete has read the foregoing and intentionally and voluntarily certifies compliance by accepting this waiver.
